PHASE-IV BEAVER CREEK SOURCE WATER PROJECT:

Contractor continues to work on site restoration activities at the Beaver Creek intake site and the water treatment plant. Jacobs engineers are tracking several punch-list items that must be completed before the end of the project. Perimeter fencing and electronic gates have been installed as well as safety railing around the backwash basins. Engineer, Contractor along with district staff are scheduled to witness the onsite 3rd party electrical evaluation of all electrical equipment at the intake and water treatment plant scheduled to begin June 6th. Once the report from the 3rd party certified electrician is received, and with no significant issues or corrections. WesTech is scheduled to be onsite the week of June 13th to resume functional testing of the membrane equipment.
