# **DRINKING WATER ADVISORY**

## **Loss of Pressure**

### **Boil Water Notice Lifted as of July 31, 2021.**

As of July 31, 2021, at 3:00 pm the Boil Water Advisory issued on July 30, 2021, is lifted. Tap water is safe to drink for all customers in the Lost Creek Community between SE 126<sup>th</sup> and 127<sup>th</sup> Drives.

Follow-up testing of drinking water has shown the absence of bacterial contamination. Seal Rock Water District recommends flushing all taps for 2 minutes or until the water runs cold before consuming for the first time. This will flush any potentially contaminated water from the plumbing.

Seal Rock Water District issued a “Boil Water Advisory” on July 30, 2021, in response to a loss of pressure as a result of a water mainline failure located in the area of SE 126<sup>th</sup> and 127<sup>th</sup> Drives. Only customers in that area were affected by this advisory.

Testing conducted within the affected area since the notice was issued was clear of contamination. The Seal Rock Water District would like to thank our customers for their cooperation and understanding during the boil water advisory. While the contamination was likely minimal, the health and safety of our customers is the District’s first priority. Seal Rock Water District consulted closely with the Oregon Health Authority – Drinking Water Services to ensure that all state and federal health procedures were followed and standards were maintained.
